ANNUAL REPORT OF SARVODAYA SAMITI FOR THE YEAR - 2021-2022

About the Organisation:

The Sarvodaya Samiti is a non-government, non-political & non-profit making organization committed for the development of tribal, rural and other underprivileged classes of the Society. The Samiti was formed by some eminent freedom fighters and dedicated social workers during the Bhoodan and Gramadan movement initiated by Acharya Binoba Bhave during 1959. The Sarvodaya Samiti was earlier known as Narayanpatna Khetra Samiti, started its operation in Koraput and Kalahandi districts of Orissa. The Samiti was registered under Societies Registration Act in the year 1970-71.



The Sarvodaya Samiti is registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 bearing the Registration No. 5883/83 of 19970-71 and Registered under the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) of 1976 No.105060002 of Government of India. The Samiti is Certified by the Khadi & Village Industries Commission, Bombay, Government of India and affiliated to the Bharatiya Adimajati Sevak Sangh, New Delhi. The area of operation of the Samiti is throughout

the state of Orissa. At present the Samiti is concentrating its work in the Koraput, Malkangiri, Rayagada, Nabarangapur, Kalahandi, Khurda & Sonepur districts of Orissa.

1. SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE & NRM

The farmers are given hands on training on sustainable agricultural, horticulture and vegetables growing practices. During the training period the farmers are exposes to the different method of practices. They also visited the Demonstrations fields and learn how to use the high yield variety seeds. Some farmers are also supplied with grafted fruit bearing trees and high yield seeds. The Samiti is promoting Palua & Turmeric cultivation by using organic manure in Koraput and Laxmipur Block of Koraput district.

2. KHADI & VILLAGE INDUSTRIES ACTIVITIES

(a) Khadi - The Sarvodaya Samiti is running three Khadi spinning centers and two weaving centers. One hundred twenty artisans are associated with the Samiti under Khadi programme. Yarn is produced from the cotton sliver on M.N.C. charakhas at Dharamgarh and weaving center at Dharamgarh. We have also a Silk production centre at Village Sagarpalli in Sonepur district.

The Samiti is also managing Khadi Bhandars (shops) in Koraput in Koraput district & Dharamgarh in Kalahandi district for sales of Khadi and village Industries products. The Samiti Annual Report 2021-22-Sarvodaya Samiti

has also sales Khadi, Silk and V.I products in whole sales within and outside state of Orissa. The Samiti is also provided work sheds to its artisans (spinners and weavers) in Dharamgarh subdivision and a Common work shed for spinning at Dharamgarh with the help from KVIC. We also produce readymade Khadi Garments for the customers.

As the cotton sliver is not available in our state, we have procured it from Central Sliver Plant of KVIC, Sehore, Madhya Pradesh & Hazipur (Bihar). The details of production and sale of Khadi by the Samiti during the year 2020-2021 is given below: -

(b) Khadi Reform Development Programme (KRDP): The Sarvodaya Samiti is implementing the KRDP in Dharamgarh sub-division of Kalahandi district. Spinners (50) were given training on operating the NMC (8 Spindle Charkha) at Dharamgarh by professional trainer from Khadi & Village Industries Commission, Bhubaneswar. During the year the Samiti has completed the Common Facilities Center (CFC) at Dharamgarh and started renovation of two sales outlets one at Koraput and other at Dharamgarh under KRDP programme.

(B) VILLAGE INDUSTRIES:

(a) BEEKEEPING - Koraput district being the main area of flora and forest, we have trained farmers to take up Beekeeping as one of the incomes generating activities. At Gandhi Nagar, Koraput we are running a Beekeeping training center. Some of the Beekeepers have started Mallifera bee colonies in Koraput district.

We have installed a Honey Processing Plant and Bottling Plant with a capacity of 100kg per day in Koraput for the benefit of the Beekeepers with the help of Khadi and Village Industries Commission under the UNDP Beekeeping programme. Now the farmers and Beekeeper are processing and bottling their honey before selling in the market. The quality as well as the demand for the processed honey has been increased in the market.

The Samiti has been helping the farmers/Beekeepers in processing & marketing of honey in Khadi Bhandars within and outside the state. The Samiti able to collect and sale honey after processing and packing are given below:-

(b) RURAL INDUSTRY SERVICE CENTRE (RISC) - The Samiti has set up a Rural Industry Service Centre at Gandhi Nagar, Koraput for the farmers of this locality. This is to provide service to the farmers cultivating Nizer seeds (oil seed) to extract oil from it for consumption purpose. This is a common facility centre for the farmers growing Nizer in Koraput. We have also given training to 25 nos of farmers for using the RISC for oil extraction. The RISC is supported by the Khadi & Village Industries Commission, Bhubaneswar. The Sarodaya Samiti is extracting Nizer Oil and Mustard Oil in the processing unit and sale in the local market.

(c) TURMERIC, PALUA & SPICES - Turmeric is locally cultivated by the tribal farmers. The Samiti is processed and packed the Turmeric, Palua, Coffee, Small Millets, Ragi & Spices through the Mahila Mandal and market it in Khadi Bhandars and other outlets. Under this programme we want to avoid the distress sale of the turmeric at a throwaway price and also to provide work to the SHGs formed by the Samiti. The Procurement and sale of the Turmeric powder & Palua is given in the above table.

3. MARKETING OF RURAL/TRIBAL PRODUCTS

The rural marketing programme has been taken up by the Samiti in the tribal areas to increase their buying and selling capacity. The tribal are also acquiring knowledge of weight, measures and market price. This is one of the programme of training for marketing. They also sale their surplus agricultural and forest products in these KVIC outlets. Sarvodaya Samiti is marketing the rural products like Turmeric, Honey, Palua, Ragi, Chattua, Black Pepper, Maize, Nizer oil, & Mustard Oil etc.

4. CAPACITY BUILDING & SKILL DEVELOPMENT:

TRAINING ON BEEKEEPING: We have organised training for SHG members on Beekeeping in Podagada, Lamataput, Semiliguda, Pottangi & Nandapur by our technical expert. The beneficiaries are trained how to handle the Indian bees and management of bees in different

seasons. They also trained on collection of honey from the bee box and it's processing for marketing.



We have also supplied Bee Colony & Bee Equipments to the SHG beneficiaries and farmers of Lamtaput, Pottangi, Semiliguda and Nanadapur of Koraput district with the financial support from Mission Shakti, Koraput and Soil Conservation Department of Dasmantapur in Koraput.

5. WOMEN & CHILD WELFARE:

Child Care Institution (Orphanage) - The Samiti is registered under Juvenile Justice Act for running a Child Care Institution (Orphanage) for 50 destitute children with the financial support from the W & C.D Department, Government of Orissa, Bhubaneswar since 1982. Out of 50 children 25 children are staying in Sisu Sadan Gandhi Nagar, Koraput. This is a residential programme and the children are reading in the nearby Govt. schools. The experience and qualified staffs are engaged to take care of the children and their development. The children are also given vocational training like spinning, weaving, crafts, carpentry, agriculture, computer, sports etc. and on agriculture for their rehabilitation in future.

(c) SWADHAR GREH: The Sarvodaya Samiti is an affiliated Institution of Bharatiya Adimjati Sevak Sangh, New Delhi and managing a SWADHAR GREH for the destitute women at Dharamgarh in the Kalahandi district of Odisha for 30 women with the financial support from the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt. of India and Department of Women & Child Development, Govt. of Odisha. The needy women/destitute women are staying in this SWADHAR GREH for a maximum period of 3 years alongwith her children. The inmates are given different vocational training like Badi, Pampad, Jam, Spinning & Weaving of Khadi, Computer, Tailoring etc for sustainable income generation for their rehabilitation. During their stay in the Swadhar Greh they are given counseling, health care and necessary legal support to rehabilitate them. In the year 2021-22 a total number of 24 inmates are rehabilitate with her parents, husband, marriage and self-employed.

7. EDUCATION & AWARENESS BUILDING:

(a) Educational Complex (Residential)- The Samiti is running an Educational Complex for 150 ST girl child at Gandhi Nagar, Koraput with the support from Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India. This is a residential school from class I to 5th class, only the Scheduled Tribe girls are admitted in this school. The objective of the schools is to improve the education and literacy rate among the female of the district. The Parents of the students are paid Rs 150/per month as incentive to encourage to send their girls to the schools. During the year 2021-2022, girls are admitted in Class –I- 30, Class-II-30, Class-III-30, Class-IV-30, Class-V-30. The total strength of the Complex during the year was 150. This year 30 students were passed out of the school from Class V and 10 students are admitted in Govt. SSD High School Mandaguda, 1 in Umri UP School, 1 in Lankaput UG high School. 06nos student are admitted in Minapai girls school,06 nos student are admitted in Manbar Govt. High School, 01nos Govt. U.P. school, Pujariput, Koraput, 5 Kalinga Sports School and others are joining nearest village school for further studies. The students are given vocational training like tailoring, leaf-cup making and spinning. The Educational Complex is also recognised by the D.I of Schools of Koraput.

8. CONSUMER PROTECTION & AWARENESS: The Sarvodaya Samiti has been recognised as one of the Voluntary Consumer Organisation by the Ministry of Civil Supplies, Government of India. The Samiti has printed some literature and leaflets in Odia language on Consumer Protection, Awareness and distributed among the people and also kept in the district development exhibition of the Koraput district. The Samiti has applied for opening of a counseling center at Koraput for the benefit of the tribal and other people of this area.

9. TEMPERANCE ACTIVITIES: The Sarvodaya Samiti has been promoting on a lifestyle free from alcohol and other drugs in the state of Odisha and a member of Yuva Bharat earlier it was known as ITYF. The Samiti is working with school children and community for awareness, prevention, reduction of substance use, education, communication, training, public awareness, and their rehabilitation. Some of the members of Sarvodaya Samiti represented the Yuva Bharat participated in the SDN National Youth camp held in Thailand held in April 2019.

At present about 260 members involved in the temperance activities, this divided into 20 groups. The members are undertaken a pledge to lead a life free from the use of alcohol and other drugs and also encourage others to lead the Heathly life style. The Samiti is working in the principles and aims and objectives of IOGT International and Yuva Bharat.

10. CRECHE CENTER: Sarvodaya Samiti is running two model Creche Centres at Burja in Laxmipur Block and at Gandhi Nagar in the Koraput block of Koraput districts for the needy and helping the ST mothers to work in their respective work places. The Children are given nutritious food during their stay in the Creche Center and in each creche centre 25 children are enrolled with a age group of 1 year to 5 year. The model Creche center is supported by Bharatiya Adimjati Sevak Sangh, New Delhi.
